

## The Pocket Listener

*Hands-free personal assistive listening device for use straight out of the box*

The Pocket Listener is a powerful, lightweight Assistive Listening Device used together with Telecoil-equipped hearing instruments. It provides users with greatly enhanced sound level and clarity from nearby sound sources or when connected directly to audio-visual equipment.

Designed for easy use straight out of the box with either single or binaural hearing instruments, *The Pocket Listener* amplifies the available sound level and noticeably improves the sound's clarity for greater hearing pleasure, even in noisy environments.

**Easy to use** – First, users select the Telecoil setting on their hearing instrument(s), then simply place *The Pocket Listener* around their neck and switch it on. The volume can be adjusted to a comfortable level by using the adjustment wheel on the side of the unit. Users will immediately notice an improvement in sound quality, whether conversing with friends and family, out shopping, or listening to a performance or speaker up to 10 meters away.

For enhanced listening pleasure to audio devices, users can also connect *The Pocket Listener* directly to their radio, stereo/HiFi, computer, or MP3 player with the jack-to-jack cable conveniently provided with the
