



Setting the correct time-

- 1) Press and hold the "TIME"set (8) button.
- 2) Depress hour button (9) as necessary to advance the clock display until the hour is correct.
- 3) Depress minute button (10) as necessary to advance the clock display until the minute is correct.
- 4) Once the time is set, release the "TIME" set (8) button.
- 5) Lighted dot (4) in upper left clock display indicates time is PM, a dot does not appear for AM.

Setting the alarm time-

- 1) Simply follow the instructions mentioned under "Setting the correct time" except that you will have to Press and hold the "ALARM" set (11) button.
- 2) Make sure the alarm time is correctly set for AM or PM lighted dot (4) indicates PM. Be sure to release the HOUR and MIN set buttons before releasing the ALARM button.
- 3) Once the time is set, release the "ALARM" set (11) button.
- 4) To enable the alarm function, slide the Function Switch (13) to the desired position. This will turn on the alarm feature. Otherwise, alarm will not go off for the alarm time set.
- 5) You will see a dot (5) on the left side of the LED display to show the alarm has been enabled.

Slide the "FUNCTION SWITCH" (13) up to the position that you desire to wake to, you can choose "VIB" for bed shaker, "BUZZ" for sound, and "VIB/BUZZ" for both. NOTE: whichever function you choose to wake to, will be the same function for both alarms. When the alarm is activated, the Flashing Display (14) will flash until the alarm is stopped.

Snooze Operation-

SNOOZE button (2) - press after alarm has sounded. The alarm will be turned off for 9minutes for extra sleep. The alarm will come back again after 9minutes. Shutting Off Alarm-

Alarm can be shut off temporary for the day or permanently shut off.

- 1) When the alarm goes off, simply press the AL off button (7) the alarm will shut itself off for the day and come back on the next day at the same time if alarm setting has not changed
- 2) To shut the alarm off permanently, slide Function Switch (13) to off position. Alarm will not come on until Function Switch (13) is set to "BUZZ" or "VIB" or "VIB/BUZZ" position.

Volume Control-

To adjust the volume rotate turn the wheel located on top right side (1) of the clock.

Tone Control-

To adjust the "TONE CONTROL" (3) turn the wheel located on top left side (3) of the clock to the desired tone sound

Bed Shaker / Vibrator- Figure B

- 1) Attach the bed shaker jack to the back of clock at VIBRATOR input (16).
- 2) To turn on vibrator slide FUNCTION Switch (13) to VIB or VIB/BUZZ
- 3) Place vibrator under mattress or pillow.

Battery Backup-

To use battery backup, you can install a 9-volt alkaline battery in the bottom of the clock located under the battery cover (12), Battery not included. Note the LED display will not show during power failure but the clock will still be running and will maintain proper time and alarm settings until the power is restored. NOTE: The battery backup only works for a short periods only, about two hours.

AC-9V Power Input -

Attach the AC power supply input to the back of clock at AC-9V IN (15) next to the VIBRATOR input, smaller input of the two.

NOTE: IMPORTANT: do not confuse "AC POWER INPUT" (15) with the "VIBRATOR INPUT"(16).
